\$10 per child per session for half day attendance.

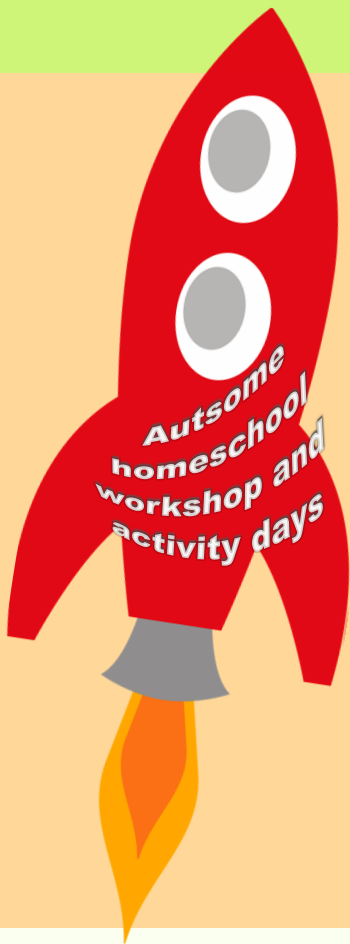

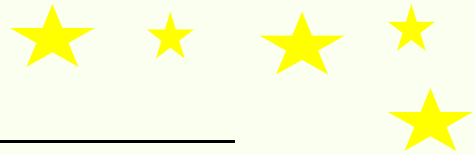
